FROM PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE:

This has been an excellent week at RCS. Students have gotten into the routine of being back at school. We would like to thank the families that attended our virtual open house yesterday. If you were unable to attend the virtual open house, here are some of the highlights.

We have made some changes to the RCS schedule that you may notice. We have added vocal music to Pre-K through 2nd grade. This is being taught by Mrs. O'Donnell once a week. The students in 6th through 8th grade are participating in "Team Builders" once a week. Team Builders is co-taught Mr. Wentworth and Ms. Korte.

We have tweaked the middle school schedule and been able to add one extra period of the Mathematics, Science/Stem and English Language Arts each week.

Mrs. Zigmand, our technology teacher, continues to have classes once a week with students in the technology lab, but she is also co-teaching in classrooms. This approach allows students to apply the technology skills they are learning and also provides an additional teacher at times.

We would like to remind families to do the COVID-19 self-screener at home each day. If you have any question about whether or not to send your student to school, please contact our school nurse Mrs. Lenfest and she will be glad to help guide you through the guidelines. We thank you for your continued cooperation as we work to keep the entire RCS community safe and healthy. We continue to encourage families to consider participating in the Routine Covid Safety Checks program. (This was known as Pool Testing last year.) Please use the link provided if you would like to take advantage of this opportunity. This consent also permits individual testing known as "Test and Stay" for a child that has limited symptoms.

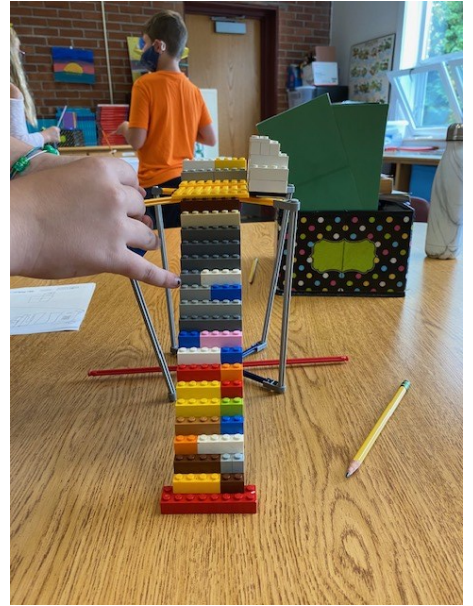

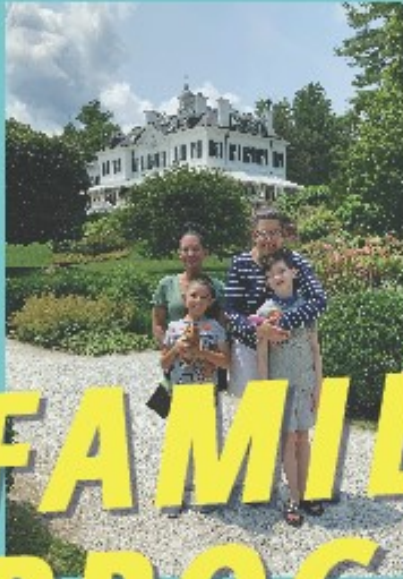
